Discussion/ Questions	<p>✓ Prayer is talking to and listening to God. Follow the directions below to explore ways that you can pray. If you need help, ask an older brother or sister, or an adult to help you.</p> <p>Choose one or more of the following activities: (turn in or take a picture required)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Praying helps us make good choices. Write a prayer asking God to help you make good choices. Pray this prayer often.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Start keeping a journal to help you talk to God. Share what happened in your life each day and how you are feeling. 3. Make a list of all the places you can pray. Then make a list of all the times of day you can pray. 4. Praying helps us make good choices. Write a prayer asking God to help you make good choices. Pray this prayer often. 5. When you watch TV, pay attention to the characters and the choices they make. Keep track of the number of good choices and bad choices characters make on the show. Think about what a character could have done differently to make a good choice. 6. Make a list of the people who help you make good choices. Make cards for these people thanking them for helping you make good choices. <hr/>
