Lesson 1 -- God Created Everything

Overview: Learn how God Created the Earth and all the creatures of the Earth.

Parents, the best way for a child to learn something is repetition, repetition, repetition.

Introduction: What does it mean to create something? (to make something) God created and creates everything. Have your child look outside and finish this sentence with things he or she sees: God created. Say: We see God’s love for us in his creation. Today we will learn about everything that God has made for us. God made everything and rested in 7 days!

Story “God Made Everything”	The first story in the Bible tells us how our world was made. God made the heavens and the earth. He made day and night. He made water and land. He made fish that live in the water. He made birds that fly in the air. He made plants and animals that live on the land. Last, he made a man and a woman. Their names were Adam and Eve. God looked at all the things he made, and he was happy. He said it was very good. God wanted to be a special friend of Adam and Eve. He wanted to teach them how to have a good, happy life. To learn these things, Adam and Eve needed to love and obey God. Then God could teach them many good things.

<p>Saint of the Week</p>	<p>(Each week an activity/video will be provide about a different saint. This week have a discussion about what a Saint is) Talk about what a hero is. What do heroes do? How do you know if someone is a hero? List some examples of heroes. Saints are heroes of the Catholic faith. They lived their lives in holiness, dedicated to serving God and spreading his message. Saints serve as examples for all Catholics, show us how to lead a more satisfying, more spiritual life with God. There are over 10,000 Saints. Each saint’s history is a fascination one. They lived in different places and times in history, but they all share a love of God. Each week we’ll learn about a different saint.</p>
<p>Summary</p>	<p>Who made everything? GOD made everything. • Who made the trees? GOD. Who made the flowers? GOD. Who made the birds? GOD • Can you name some things God made? • What is your favorite thing that God has made? • What is a Catholic hero called?</p>
<p>Ending Prayer</p>	<p>We will learn a prayer that reminds us that we belong to God. It’s called the Sign of the Cross. Face your child as you demonstrate the gestures for the Sign of the Cross. Then turn your back and use exaggerated movements, making sure your child can see where you’re placing your hands. Have your child practice.</p> <p>Kids often get confused with left and right hand.
