Lesson 2 -- God Made Us and Cares for Us

Overview:

God made humans. God loves us and wants us to love each other.

Parents, the best way for a child to learn something is repetition, repetition. Children learn best by watching and doing.

Objectives:

- Identify that all life and all of creation are gifts from God who loves us.
- God loves us and gave us the gift of life.
- Recite and demonstrate the sign of the cross.

Introduction:

God is our Heavenly Father, who created us because he loves us. Since God is the Father of everyone we should love everyone in his family. God gives us all good gifts and we should thank him when we talk to him in prayer

Discuss what it feels like to be a part of your family. Ask: How do we as a family show that we care about one another? (help with chores, play together, hug family members)

Ask: What would you do to help someone new feel welcome? (say hello, include him or her in a game) Say: Today we'll learn how much God loves us and how we can show his love to others.
